
5 year warranty




Disassembly

1. Detach the wooden board from the brackets by removing the screws located underneath the board. To do so, use an Allen key and turn it



2. To remove the brackets from the wall, unscrew the fasteners connecting each bracket to the wall as shown.



3. Finally, remove the threaded inserts from the wooden board by using a larger Allen key and turning

it counterclockwise.
